Why do I need to complete a bridging activity?

How will I be given feedback?

Summary of the activity

Research into local galleries / exhibition review.

Select any exhibition at a local gallery you know about, and can travel to easily, arrange to spend a minimum of an hour there and carry out a simple investigation into this space and the type of work you see there.

Write a 150-word hand written summary about this exhibition and gallery.

Ideas for your summary could include:

- The name of the exhibition, or artists' work shown in the space.
- Where it is located, what facilities there are contained within the gallery.
- The type of work you have seen, its main visual qualities, strengths and weaknesses.
- Your opinions, are they positive or negative?
- Would you recommend this exhibition to others and why?
- Include pictures or comments from people who attended with you if it helps your review.
