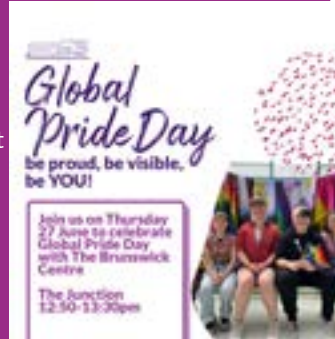

Cyber savvy top tip

Avoid the ads!

When using search engines in the browser please do not click on the first link you come to these are known as 'sponsored links' which can cause potential issues:

- Scammers/hackers can hijack these, and this can lead to inadvertent filtering blocks and potential malware attacks, they can also send false reporting to the Safeguarding team.
- Good practice is to scroll down a bit each time you search, and you won't have to worry about supporting a scammer. Often these links aren't what you're searching for anyway, or, if they are, they lead you to "deals" or other pages you're not interested in
